We are now accepting mass intentions through June 30, 2022. With the mass schedule spread across the four parishes of our partnership, it is important that we follow Canon Law and Diocesan Policy concerning mass intentions: Only one intention (person) per Mass is allowed. However, for pastoral concerns to better accommodate the needs of the parishioners, we will adhere to the following: Up to three first names with the same last name (i.e., John, Paul and Mary Smith) or two last names only (i.e., Scott and Smith Families) will be allowed per intention. We can accept up to three Mass offerings per mass. Mass intentions cannot be scheduled for the following days: Holy Thursday, Holy Saturday, Easter, Christmas, Mothers' Day, Fathers' Day, Memorial Day, All Souls Day, First Communion and Confirmation. These Mass intentions will be for the general intentions of our parishioners.

The annual Cookie Walk this year will be held on December 18 and 19 after each Mass in the multi-purpose room. The Cookie Walk will consist of containers prepackaged with homemade cookies. We will have small containers with approximately ½ dozen cookies, medium containers with approximately 1 ½ dozen cookies, and large tray with 3 dozen cookies.
