CHRISM MASS AT CATHEDRAL OF ST.

PETER: On Tuesday of Holy Week, April 12, 2022, at 11:30 AM. During this Mass, with the Priests, Deacons, Confirmandi, and members of the Christian Faithful gathered together, Bishop McGovern will consecrate the Sacred Chrism and bless the Oil of the Catechumens and the Oil of the Sick that will be used throughout the Diocese in the coming year. Because of the easing of COVID restrictions, we are now able to gather together in person at the Mass. The Mass will also be livestreamed and recorded to allow parishioners the opportunity to view the Mass. Please let Fr. Mark, Fr. Felix or Deacon Steve know if you are interested in attending.
